

A DEDICATION FOR YOUR TITHES

Tithing is not something that can be done in the few seconds before the plate is passed in church. It must be done on purpose. Write your tithe checks, hold them before God, and take the time to pray and confess God's Word over them. Your money then becomes a tool used in worshipping God. The following confession is based on Deuteronomy 26 as a guide for you to use in praying over your tithes. It is our confession of redemption equivalent to Israel's deliverance from Egypt. We thank You, Father, in Jesus' Name.

PROSPERITY CONFESSION

Because the Lord is my shepherd, I do not want (Ps. 23:1). I do not want for any good thing, for He does not withhold it from me as I walk uprightly before Him (Ps. 84:11).
